## 5. Method

From 1 July to 30 June 2023, customers can donate their unwanted clothing items, in good condition, to Humana People to People, using the collection points available in OVS stores. The items brought in store must be packaged inside a closed bag, preferably breathable, containing at least 2–3 items. For each bag, customers will receive a discount voucher for the value of 5 euros that they can use on items from the new collection, with a minimum spend of 40 euros.

The following items are accepted:

- $\cdot$  all menswear, womenswear, and kidswear items
- $\cdot\, {\rm shoes}\, {\rm and}\, {\rm sandals}$
- · bags and backpacks
- · clothing accessories (hats, belts, scarves, head scarves, capes)
- $\cdot$  home linens and furnishing fabrics.

Bags containing unwanted clothing items must be placed in the special collection containers. Discounts can only be used individually and are valid in all participating OVS stores and at ovs.it for a period of 6 months from the date of issue. Each discount voucher is for use in a single transaction: it cannot be converted into cash, either wholly or in part; no change will be given, not even in the form of another discount. Discount vouchers cannot be used with other special ofers.

## 6. Ownership and processing of delivered items

Once delivered, unwanted clothing items become the property of Humana, the partner of OVS in the delivery of this project. Humana is a not-for-proft association with the purpose of boosting development of poorer nations in the southern areas of the world through specifc projects that work towards improving living conditions for people in difficulty. To achieve this aim, Humana focuses on collecting unwanted clothing items - donated by individuals or organisations - which it resells through its own sales outlets in order to fnance the development projects it promotes.
